

DECENT WORK: OUR JOB !

On the 10th of December 2008, The Centrale Generale FGTB organised an international seminar on decent work, with the participation of our project partners in the South and different unions with whom we have good bilateral relations.

At the end of this seminar the participants have subscribed a common declaration, defining a strategy towards the defence of the interest of informal/temporary workers and subcontractors.

Our union strategy is therefore based on the following 6 principles:

- Regular employment comes first
- No discrimination
- Respect ILO-conventions
- Decent pay for decent work
- Struggle for more equality and respect for human rights
- Occupational health and safety prevention is a priority for all employees

In this declaration, the participating unions call for a day of common action and sensitization against working accidents and occupational diseases, on April 28. An annual common statement and action calendar will be set up in partnership with the European and International sectorial federations. The colloquium calls for the organisation of an international action day for interim workers.

The 28th of April is therefore the opportunity to launch a joint action with the European and International sector federations.
